



## ***Your Art, Your Health, Your Clinic***

*The new Artist Clinic at Country Doctor Community Clinic has launched!*

*Subsidies available! Uninsured low-income artists can apply for a voucher to help underwrite appointment costs.*

Like all citizens of Washington State, artists need affordable health care. For more than four years, an Artist Trust-led initiative – the Washington Artists Health Insurance Project\* (WAHIP) – has examined the health care needs of working artists. An important aspect of receiving timely health care is having information about a source of quality care at a reasonable cost. A modest subsidy can help make medical care more affordable for low-income, uninsured artists.

WAHIP, in partnership with The Country Doctor Community Clinic (CDCC) in Seattle’s Capitol Hill neighborhood, is pleased to announce the launch of its new “Artist Clinic.”

### **How does the Artist Clinic work?**

Starting in January 2009 and running for a 12-month trial period, the Artist Clinic at Country Doctor is offering artist-focused hours every Wednesday from 5:30pm–8:30pm. Artists of all disciplines are encouraged to call 206/299-1600 to make an appointment and efforts will be made to accommodate your schedule.

### **Am I eligible for a WAHIP medical subsidy?**

If you define yourself as an artist, then you are encouraged to participate in the Artist Clinic. Low-income artists that do request subsidy support from WAHIP, are required to complete a short form intended to determine your artistic discipline, percent of income from art practice, time spent on creation of work and education and/or training. WAHIP reserves the right to determine your eligibility.

During this trial first year, there are a limited number of subsidies available on a first-come, first-served basis. If you are eligible, a \$75 voucher will be issued to you to be applied toward your Artist Clinic bill from Country Doctor Clinic to a maximum of \$150 (2 vouchers) per individual artist during 2009.

### **What services can I receive at the Artist Clinic?**

Artists can receive the full spectrum of primary and preventive services provided by the medical professionals of the Country Doctor Community Clinic including:

- Care for all adult illnesses;
- Preventive health counseling and routine health exams;
- Birth control services;

- Sexually transmitted disease treatment and counseling;
- Chronic disease management for such diseases as high blood pressure, diabetes and HIV;
- Immunizations;
- Nutrition counseling;
- Complementary medicine including acupuncture and naturopathic services;
- Behavioral health counseling for patients referred by a CDCC provider;
- Common medications at affordable rates;
- Diabetes education and disease management services to patients referred by a CDCC provider;
- Nutrition counseling to medical clients referred by a CDCC provider;
- Specialty care referral on a sliding scale basis; in most cases. CDCC physicians take care of you in the hospital.

**Where is the new Artist Clinic located?**

The Artist Clinic is a service of the Country Doctor Community Clinic, located at 500 19<sup>th</sup> Ave. East & E. Republican on Capitol Hill in Seattle. **Will I need to do anything else?**

Yes! Mention WAHIP when calling Country Doctor Community Clinic for an appointment and when at the front desk at CDCC to ensure that you are offered the subsidy option.
